

FOOD AND CLOTHING BANK PANTRY GUIDELINES

The Food and Clothing Bank holds a monthly Food Pantry on the **third Thursday of each month from 2:00 - 6:00 p.m.** at St. Paul's U.C.C. Parish House, 8 North Belleville Street, Freeburg. Clothing is available during the entire Pantry time. Pantry sign up begins at 1:30 p.m. To be eligible an applicant must:

1. Live in the Freeburg High School District (Freeburg, Smithton, Fayetteville, St. Libory, Floraville or Paderborn);
2. Apply in person;
3. Bring proof of residency (electric bill, medical card, telephone bill, etc.);
4. Bring proof of income for each person living in the household (pay stubs, copy of checks, food stamp stubs, et.)
5. Be within these income guidelines:
