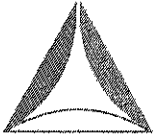

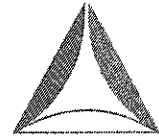

Report to Mayor and Village Board for Monday April 19,2021

A. Monthly Tornado Siren Test on April 6th, PW Director John T. and several Freeburg residents with the area of the Fire Department /Old Power Plant reported extremely "low" sound and very muffled sound from siren operation. The siren was rechecked, manually controlled from the siren switches on site and it began to open fuses and stop operation. This failure occurred on one of our largest AND oldest outdoor siren units. In fact, this siren, the Federal Sign and Signal Corp., Thunderbolt model, was one of the original sirens obtained through Defense Civil Preparedness Agency (now known as FEMA) grant that I and the Mayor Favre Government obtained back in 1975/76.

I contacted Blue Valley Safety Inc, the vendor and technical support company for the Federal Model Sirens to request a technician for service response to this siren unit after consultation with our Pw director John T. On Thursday April 8, 2021, BVPS tech. arrived for service and advised it was the Blower Motor-3 phase unit. Due to the age of the unit, only a refurbished motor could be used and if their company obtained one, it would have a very limited "warranty" period due to issues with parts availability.

I contacted Village Admin. Tony F., to brief him on this situation and my need to now have this 46 year old siren replaced at its earliest opportunity. I was advised to get Tony a quote for a full replacement unit, of the same power and coverage area as that of the older unit, and have it to him by 11:00AM Monday April 12, 2021. I immediately contacted BVPS, Inc., obtained the information and submitted to Admin. Tony's office by start of business on Monday April 12th. I requested the bid information for the same configuration as that of our last newest siren we purchased for use (the Village installed) at the SAVE site with battery back up.

I have enacted our Freeburg ESDA Emergency Operations Plan that covers such an incident, if a siren unit is out, whereby the police and/or fire department would use their respective vehicle Public Address systems from their emergency vehicle's to advise if a Tornado Warning was issued for the Village. The PD officers that were on duty April 9th for a Severe Thunderstorm Warning event, acknowledged they received notification from the Pd Chief on my reference to our EOP and were ready to respond if necessary. This operation will continue until the failed Tornado Siren is replaced and back in service.

B. ESDA office activated for a Severe Thunderstorm Warning that was issued on Friday April 9, 2021 at 7:26 pm. This Severe Thunderstorm warning was issued by NWS based on radar data indicating a severe thunderstorm was located over Sparta, Ill., and moving NE at 15 mph. This "cell" near approached or got near to the Freeburg area as it remained ESE and was moving ENE of our area. Shelter Managers were told to stand down but be on standby and the ESDA EOC office remained in operation beyond the 8:15 PM ending time for the warning. In fact the warning was cancelled at 8:00 PM by the St. Louis Office of the NWS. ARES/RACES communications was enabled and active until 9:00 PM until all storm cells were completely out of the County.

C. A "high wind advisory" was issued for St. Louis City and County as well as Madison County on April 10, 2021, but not St. Clair County. However the NWS office called to verify our highest wind speeds as the very deep low pressure system (no thunderstorm produced pressure gradient) was moving across our area at 2:45 - 6:00 pm. Freeburg ESDA weather instrumentation readings given to NWS as follows: 3PM=43 mph; 4:30 pm=41 mph; 5:00 pm = 39 mph; and 5:30 pm = 32 MPH all wind direction indications were from the WSW. No wind related damage reported to the ESDA office during this period. Again, this was non-thunderstorm produced winds.

D. PPE PA Grant follow up through our FEMA portal indicates, as of 4/8/2021 that a "DM" draft was completed by a Mr. Andy Aughenbaugh of FEMA. Now pending the OCC review, of which I will be checking to determine exactly how this moving to our reimbursement of purchased PPE items and its final approved amount.

E. ESDA office advised by Country Mart Store Pharmacy : Megan H., that they have been given CDC approval and St. Clair County Health Department approval to provide COVID19 vaccinations ! I immediately inquired on dates, times, etc., and then forwarded this information to our Zone Admin. to see if this data could be placed on the Village FB website. This request was also copied to our Village Public Safety Chairperson. I checked our Village FB page and confirmed that someone placed the information on it. Thank you !

Races/AuxCom communication exercise was conducted from the Freeburg ESDA office at 6:30 pm – 7:45 PM on Tuesday evening April 13, 2021.

G. Public Works Director John T. with PW Shane K., will be working with me on a Siren PM chart to involve “mechanical” inspections per manufacturer recommendations to coincide with the “monthly siren testing” operations.

I continue to send out letters, make phone calls, and follow up on letters sent out to properties that are in violation. This process will really start to ramp up as spring arrives and we start to see grass grow. I have submitted an article in the Tribune about Pools within the Village. I plan to submit another article about Recreational Vehicles in the Village next.

There are currently two new homes being built in Edison Estates, one villa and one home. The contractor has started to bring in rip rap for the drainage areas and has cut a ditch in a low area that was holding water for a temporary fix.

There are 3 new basements in at Meadow Pines as of this past week. I talked to the developer about Phase 2 and they have been in contact with the engineer, bank, and contractor about starting in a few months. I reminded them that they need to work out and complete their issue of overhead lines with Charter before they get to far.

The Zoning Code is live and online as a part of our full code. We only have 1 link that is 100% searchable as a part of the full code now. This was a long time coming, but it seems to be worth the wait. Thank you once again to everybody whom had a part of completing this project.

The Combined Board met on Tuesday 4/13 to discuss the B-1 District. No action was taken at this time, but we will continue to discuss a possible modification to that zoning district which is predominantly around the square park.

2. Customer Issues: Head Lineman Shane Krauss advised they took care of issues at a mobile home on E. Hill that had a wire down in the backyard, a loose old connection to a weatherhead on Main St., a single phase primary on Cemetery, and replaced a rotted pole on Elizabeth.
3. IMEA Energy Efficiency Grant: Public Works Director John Tolan advised we will receive an additional \$11,000 on May 1st and would like to earmark \$5,000 - \$6,000 for LED lighting. We have another business that has talked to Matt and Shane about this program. They are currently not a Village of Freeburg utility customer, but their project should fit into this year's allotment.

Trustee Lisa Meehling motioned to grant SAVE'S Electric Efficiency Grant in the amount of \$8,103.75 for their LED lighting project and Trustee Mike Heap seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.

4. North Substation CAT Work/PLC Unit #12 Fail Repair/Replacement: Chuck Fiessinger presented their generator controls upgrade proposal. He advised the controls at the south plant are 25 years old and parts are becoming obsolete. He stated it is harder to obtain the replacement parts to keep our equipment going. The north plant is experiencing issues when ISO has to come in and do work. They are using obsolete computers, and if they can't get anyone down here, we have to wait on them. Chuck explained our old plant is analog, and the new plant is digital. If there is a problem, we have to determine where it is. If we upgrade, everything will communicate with each other. This upgrade should last through our contract with IMEA. In 2018, they installed a system in Highland. We are welcome to visit and see how it operates. Chuck also advised the proposed system will be a non-proprietary system

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meaning we own all of it and anyone can work on it. Every system is different and ours would be customized to Freeburg. The generators will communicate with each other and act as one big unit. We will be able to see the units at both plants at one time. The proposal included options to upgrade each plant separately. If we do everything at one time, that will eliminate 2 integrations. Training is included in the price. Shane confirmed we are down to it being a matter of when this needs to be done. Mayor Speiser commented we need to supply our residents with power. Chuck advised the work would be done during off peak times so we don't lose any credits from IMEA. The committee requested this be sent to Finance Committee for further discussion.

5. Project #21-01: Breaker Repair and Upgrade: Shane advised the second breaker has been received and will be installed tomorrow. Item can be taken off the agenda.

John has submitted the repair invoices and IMEA penalty on the flooding at the old plant to Erie Insurance. We are waiting to hear back from them. Matt advised Klemme is looking to start phase 2 at Meadow Pines. He mentioned the increase in material costs. Shane said we are about 8 weeks out on transformers.

B. NEW BUSINESS: None.

C. GENERAL CONCERNS: None.

D. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION: Janet had questions on BHM&G's presentation.

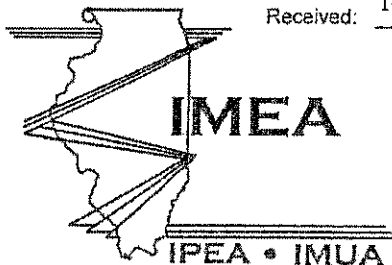

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE MEETING Trash/Water/Sewer (Kaiser/Blaies/Heap/Meehling) Wednesday, April 14, 2021 at 5:45 p.m.

The Public Works Committee Meeting was called to order at 5:55 p.m. on Wednesday, April 14, 2021, by Chairman Bob Kaiser. Members present were Chairman Bob Kaiser, Trustee Mike Blaies, Trustee Mike Heap, Trustee Lisa Meehling, Mayor Seth Speiser, Village Clerk Jerry Menard, Trustee Denise Albers, Trustee Ray Matchett, Public Works Director John Tolan, Water/Sewer Department Head Gregg Blomenkamp, Crew Worker Trevor Breitwieser, Village Attorney Fred Keck, Village Administrator Tony Funderburg and Office Manager Julie Polson. Guest present: Susan Carpenter and Janet Baechle. There were no guests present via Zoom.

A. OLD BUSINESS:

1. Approval of March 10, 2021 minutes: Trustee Mike Blaies motioned to approve the March 10, 2021 minutes and Trustee Mike Heap seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.
2. New Sewer Plant/Sewer Loan: Village Administrator Tony Funderburg advised we have 60 days to get the bid approval finalized. We are waiting on EPA, and Tony advised at 61 days, the contractor can start charging more. We asked Burns & McDonnell to contact Chad Rice to move it along. We hope to be able to let Haier start buying materials and want to have Haier's price guaranteed.
3. Sewer issues: John advised there was a clogged manhole in Meadow Piness and they cleaned it out with the hydro excavator. He confirmed there was nothing in there when the sewer inspections were being done. Trevor is checking the area weekly. John said there may be another manhole problem or a clean out broken off.
4. FSH Minutes: They are moving forward with the new development in Mascoutah. John said SLM's average daily water usage is 3,600,000 gallons with a peak of 4,400,000. Their max is 5,600,000 gallons per day. The new development wants 1,000,000 gallons a day.
5. Old Freeburg Road Water Line: Attorney Keck advised there was a contract revision that is incomplete. He would like to revise the contract and resubmit it to Haier for their review and ask them if they are in agreement with the revision. Attorney Keck said John went out of his way to get these modifications made to the contract, and they were not handled appropriately.

Trustee Lisa Meehling motioned to recommend the Haier Plumbing & Heating, Inc.'s Amended Construction Contract in the amount of \$164,768 for approval and Trustee Mike Blaies seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.

Trustee Mike Blaies motioned to recommend to the full Board TWM Invoice #69188 in the amount of \$3,522.07 for approval and Trustee Lisa Meehling seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.

6. Water System Study: John advised TWM is coming to May meeting for their Water System Study Presentation.
7. Repair/Replace Sewer Main East and West Apple: On hold.
8. West Street Residents' Sewer Issue: On hold.


John stated Wiegmann's completed the USEPA audit and are close to resuming their discharge process. He asked that Wiegmanns inform him ahead of time and send him the results. They have a new plant manager.

B. NEW BUSINESS: Tony is working on the builder's risk policy application and will get that turned into our agent soon. He met with Waste Management yesterday to review our options on the trash contract that expires August 31st. At some point, we will need to decide whether we want curbside recycling or the recycling center. The Township wants to close the center itself. Due to Waste Management's efforts in recycling plastic and methane, our prices may be lower. This will be discussed in an upcoming Committee as a Whole meeting.

C. GENERAL CONCERNS: None

D. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION: Susan Carpenter was present to request a \$2,400 reimbursement for her backflow preventer that malfunctioned. The backflow preventer was installed in 2005. She stated no-one ever told her when it was installed that it would be her responsibility to maintain. Village Administrator Tony Funderburg said the lateral is the homeowner's responsibility. John advised the plumber if he ran the line, he risked breaking the valve. Tony said it has always been our position that the homeowner is responsible and needs to clean and maintain it. The committee will take this under advisement. Ms. Carpenter left the meeting at 6:11 p.m. Both Mayor Speiser and Attorney Keck commented the backflow preventer worked for 15 years.

E. ADJOURN: *Trustee Mike Blaies motioned to adjourn the meeting at 6:41 p.m. and Trustee Mike Heap seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.*

The meeting of the Public Property Committee was called to order at 6:42 p.m., on Wednesday, April 14, 2021, by Chairman Ray Matchett. Guest present: None. There were no guests present via Zoom.

POOL: A. OLD BUSINESS: None.

B. NEW BUSINESS:

1. Pool Staffing: Julie advised we have received one lifeguard application from Gabrielle Yates. She would like to get her hired for the position.

Trustee Denise Albers motioned to recommend to the full Board Gabrielle Yates be hired as a lifeguard for the 2021 pool season at \$11 per hour and Trustee Mike Heap seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.

The committee was in agreement with lowering the age to 15 for lifeguards as long as they have the Red Cross certification and training and work permit from the school district. Tony advised we will be short on lifeguards, the existing guards may have to pick up more hours, and we may hire just a couple kids to work only in concession. Tanner has taken a job somewhere else, so we will also need to hire another manager. The committee was in agreement to place the additional help wanted on the website.

1. Approval of March 10, 2021 Minutes: *Trustee Denise Albers motioned to approve the March 10, 2021 minutes and Trustee Mike Heap seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.*
2. E. Apple Street Proposed Repair: Nothing new at this time.
3. Drainage Problem Areas/Stormwater Run-Off: Public Works Director John Tolan reported they are working on areas around town. With the warmer weather, we are receiving many requests from residents that want their issues taken care of immediately.
4. Customer Issues: None.
5. MFT: The bid opening for the oil and rock will be here on April 27th.

Trustee Denise Albers motioned to recommend to the full Board TWM Invoice #69042 in the amount of \$820.90 for approval and Trustee Mike Heap seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.

6. Surplus 2 N. Railroad HVAC: John will get a description for advertisement in the paper.
7. RFQ for Water/Sewer/Streets: Tony prepared an RFP and would like to discuss this in the Committee as a Whole meeting.

Trustee Albers asked John for the West St. estimate.

B. NEW BUSINESS:

1. St. Joseph Catholic School Donation Request: The committee agreed to donate a 10-session pass.
2. ESDA Siren Quote – Equipment Only: Tony advised John is going to get the existing siren fixed for approximately \$700. We would like to purchase a new siren with a battery backup. The siren will be installed in an area that provides better coverage.

Trustee Denise Albers motioned to recommend to the full Board purchase of a Federal Signal Model #2001 tornado siren at a cost of \$17,162.60 and Trustee Mike Heap seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.

3. Police Department New Vehicle Purchase Request: Tony believes it is in the village's best interests to purchase all four police Ford Interceptors now and pay for them over five years. He noted two years ago, we paid \$10,000 less per vehicle. With the chip and material shortages, there may be a limit on the number of vehicles being manufactured for municipalities. Interest rates are low right now, and Tony said he is looking at everything getting more expensive and is trying to address that now. With one driver who is responsible to maintain the vehicle, it should last eight years. Chief Schutzenhofer is being told there will be a 3 - 5% increase for the new vehicles. The trustees were concerned with buying all 4 vehicles at once.

Trustee Denise Albers motioned to recommend to the full Board the purchase of two Ford Police Interceptors at a cost of \$43,980 each and Trustee Mike Heap seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.

Tony advised a grant became available today for body and in-car cameras. Mayor Speiser left the meeting at 7:00 p.m.

4. Public Works Department New Vehicles Purchase Request. John advised the contracts are getting ready to come out, and the dealer told him that we should be ready to go by May 1st since there not many purchases last year, as well as the chip shortage. John would like to get rid of 2 of the Dodge Dakotas and the 1992 chip truck. There were no public works vehicles purchased last year. All of the new vehicles are 4x4 and safety equipped. The F-550 price includes the snow plow and spreader as well as a stainless steel bed so the salt doesn't corrode the bed. There is a 16-week turnaround on the F150, and the other two are 22 – 24 weeks out. These vehicles would be paid off over 3 years.

Trustee Denise Albers motioned to recommend to the full Board the purchase of one F150 at a cost of \$36,604; one F350 at a cost of \$53,362 and one F550 at a cost of \$88,208 per State Bid and Trustee Mike Heap seconded the motion.

Tony said the Library has requested a permanent structure for their story walk events in our Village Park. John advised they have been doing this with a non-permanent sign that works well. The committee did not permanent structures installed at the Village Park.

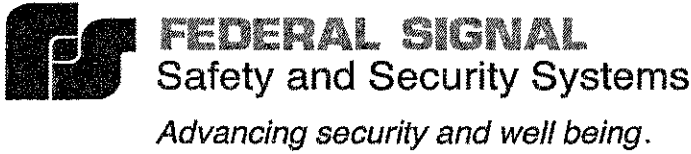
