Non-Highway Vehicles

The Village of Freeburg has passed an ordinance allowing non-highway vehicles to be operated on designated streets within the Village. **You must be 21 years of age** and have a valid driver's license. The vehicle must be properly titled with the Illinois Secretary of State and also provide proof of insurance for the non-highway vehicle. The vehicle must be properly registered with the Village of Freeburg and display such registration.

LEAF PICKUP PROGRAM




