The meeting of the Public Property Committee was called to order at 6:49 p.m., on Wednesday, April 11, 2018, in the Municipal Center by Chairman Ray Matchett. Members present were Chairman Ray Matchett, Trustee Denise Albers, Trustee Dean Pruett, Trustee Matt Trout, Mayor Seth Speiser, Village Clerk Jerry Menard (absent), Trustee Mike Blaies, Trustee Lisa Meehling, Village Attorney Fred Keck, Public Works Director John Tolan, Police Chief Mike Schutzenhofer, Village Administrator Tony Funderburg (absent) and Office Manager Julie Polson. Guest present: Janet Baechle.

POOL: A. OLD BUSINESS:

1. Pool – Lifeguard Hire: Office Manager Julie Polson advised we received two more applications for lifeguard and that will be it.

Trustee Matt Trout motioned to recommend to the full Board Zachery Conaway and Jenna Coil be hired as lifeguards at \$8.25 per hour and Trustee Denise Albers seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.

Public Works Director John Tolan advised Moore Asphalt will be here Friday to put the subsurface down. They have come up with an idea to put a drain in to keep the water out. John stated we will start working on the pool soon. Trustee Trout stated the Chamber is doing a spotlight article in the Tribune for the businesses and is going to do something on the pool.

B. NEW BUSINESS:

1. Freeburg District #70 PTO Donation Request: The committee granted a 10-day pool pass to the Spring Carnival on May 17, 2018.

STREETS: A. OLD BUSINESS:

1. Approval of March 14, 2018 Minutes: *Trustee Matt Trout motioned to approve the March 14, 2018 minutes and Trustee Dean Pruett seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.*
2. E. Apple Street Proposed Repair: John reviewed this project with Jeff at TWM and they came up with a couple of ideas.
3. Drainage Problem Areas (Hill Mine Rd.)/Stormwater Run-Off: John stated with the recent heavy rains, they did have a few areas at High/Edison, N. Alton by Mr. Krieg's home that were fixed. John said the meeting at the high school went well.
4. Customer Issues: None.

5. Subdivision Streets Material Requirements: John stated we came to an agreement on this. Julie advised it will have to go to the Combined Planning/Zoning Board for a public hearing.

Trustee Albers asked John to check with IDOT on the left turn yield sign at the Apple/State Street intersection.

B. NEW BUSINESS:

1. Resident Request for Sidewalk Replacement: John advised he will put this on the list to do. He has driven around town looking at other areas to fix.
2. A.B.A.T.E. of Illinois Request for Motorcycle Safety and Awareness Proclamation:
Will put on Monday's agenda.
3. Summer Hires: John advised Jeff Loesche, Ben Ebel and Noah Carpenter are not coming back. Dick Mense will work for the summer, but John would like to hire 1-2 more workers.
4. MFT Bids: John stated the bid opening was held Monday. We did not have anyone bid on the slag. He talked to Beelman and the cost is \$21.35 per ton. Two years ago, we paid \$13 per ton, and last year we paid \$15 per ton. Chips are \$10.54 per ton and we need 990 tons. He advised he has about half stockpiled, and will use it up this year in town and then chip on Wolf Road and parts of Barber Lane. John said we made efforts to send the bid package to Funk, Dambachers and Rogers. Jon Schaller from IDOT advised to kick out Funk's bid since they put a zero in the rip rap and it is bid as a group.

Mayor Speiser left the meeting at 6:55 p.m.

John advised we received a work order request to remove an extremely large tree in a resident's front yard at 6 S. Edison. He wanted board approval before he cuts it down. Trustee Pruett asked John the next time Deterding Tree Service is in town, have them look at it. John confirmed it is on our property.

C. GENERAL CONCERNS: John said this is the final leaf pickup week before fall. During rainy days, they will be working on concreting the backhoe shed floor and clearing the right of way on Wolf Road where the subdivision is going to go.

D. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION: Janet advised the Village Hall parking lot has cracks.

E. ADJOURN: *Trustee Matt Trout motioned to adjourn the meeting at 7:15 p.m. and Trustee Denise Albers seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.*
