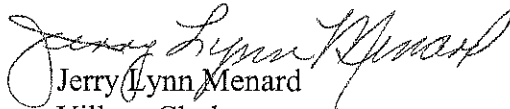

**OLD BUSIENSS:**

Trustee Meehling said Chief Schutzenhofer advised the committee the new hires are in place and working out well. We have put the patrol car that we were getting rid of in service, so each officer now has their own vehicle. Chief Schutzenhofer reported the accident on West Apple Street turned fatal, and that will now be handle by the State's Attorney's office to see if they will seek charges. With regards to Sheets dogs, this issue has been resolved and a fence has been installed. Village Administrator Tony Funderburg brought up a new legislation that will be affected next year. Trustee Meehling said Chief Schutzenhofer has been attending meetings regarding that. We don't have to comply until 2025. The SROs are working out very well at both schools.

**Electric Committee Meeting:** Trustee James (Mike) Blaies (Chairperson) reported on the Electric Committee Meeting held on Wednesday, October 12, 2022 at 5:30 p.m.

**The following item or items were talked about or discussed:**

1. Customer Issues: Trustee Blaies said Head Lineman Shane Krauss reported outages on August 9/12 where their service was ripped off from a storm; SAVE's 3 phrase service that serves the 911 radio tower had a blown fuse on 9/23; we had two customers out on N. State on 10/9 that was animal related; Reifschneiders had animal issues and Head Lineman Shane Krauss took care of that; and the whole north circuit was taken out for about 15-30 minutes.
2. IMEA Energy Efficiency Grant: Public Works Director John Tolan advised the committee IMEA held an energy efficiency meeting this week. We have \$2,773 left over from last year and \$11,094 from this year that needs to be used or we lose it. We hope to use it on some of the business in town.
3. Generator Upgrades: Trustee Blaies said BHM&G is in the process of doing the work right now and they are about half way done. John said they are very close in finishing the old plant.

*Trustee James (Mike) Blaies motioned to pay BHM&G Invoice #2185-101 in the amount of \$16,831.4, and Trustee Ramon Matchett, Jr. seconded the motion. 1. Freeburg High School Solar Project: Trustee Blaies said Village Administrator Tony Funderburg said the high school would like to install solar on their new addition. The committee had a discussion on that. Public Works Director John Tolan advised the committee there is a resident on Rock Hill Road that would like to install a ground-mounted system. We had a discussion on that.

Head Lineman Shane Krauss advised the committee they shut down the west plant for about 2 hours to prepare for the new transformer.

**Public Works Committee Meeting: (Trash/Water/Sewer)** Trustee Robert (Bob) Kaiser (Chairperson) reported on the Trash/Water/Sewer Committee Meeting held on Wednesday, October 12 2022 at 6:00 p.m.

#### **The following item or items were talked about or discussed:**

1. New Sewer Plant/Sewer Loan: Trustee Kaiser said under the new sewer plant he would like to make a motion.

*Trustee Robert (Bob) Kaiser motioned to the approval of Haier Plumbing & Contracting Pay Request #13 in the amount of \$495,618.72, and Trustee James (Mike) Blaies seconded the motion. ROLL CALL:* Trustee Robert (Bob) Kaiser – aye; Trustee James (Mike) Blaies – aye; Trustee Elizabeth (Lisa) Meehling – aye; Trustee Ramon Matchett, Jr. – aye; Trustee Michael (Mike) Heap – aye; Trustee Denise Albers – absent; (5 ayes, 0 nays, 1 absent). **All voting aye, the motion carried.**

Trustee Kaiser said Zoning Administrator Matt Trout said they are running pipe and conduit connecting all buildings and tanks; working on the anaerobic basins and starting to block the filter building. Trustee Kaiser said he, John, and Eric, Trevor and Buddy are going to SCADA system training tomorrow. Village Administrator Tony Funderburg provided a spreadsheet which shows amounts billed to date with a remaining \$75,542.00 left to bill us.

Trustee Kaiser stated Public Works Director John Tolan reported another issue at the old sewer plant. A wall rusted through, and divestor sludge was leaking through into the creek. We had Metro Ag pump the sludge out of the divestor, and Wolf Fabrication will be here next week to weld a patch onto the tank.

2. Sewer Issues: Trustee Kaiser said Public Works Director John Tolan reported the Fire Department ambulance shed had a backup. There is no basement, and we are fine. It looks to be something in the lateral.

3. FSH Minutes: Nothing to report.

4. Water System Study: Trustee Kaiser said Public Works Director John Tolan made two attempts to try and meet with Scott on this, and has not received any response.

5. Repair/Replace Sewer Main East and West Apple: Trustee Kaiser stated this project is done. This was quite the project ran into a few issues. We lowered the manhole in the alley; we replaced 170 feet of sewer line; we did hit a 2-inch unmarked gas main. John Feder was very easy to work with. Insituform is scheduled for the 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> to line that.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Trustee Kaiser said Public Works Director John Tolan reported that the hydrant flushing has been completed, the disinfectant has been switched back to chloramine residual, installed the Dollar General water service on Foxtail, and also Mr. Luge on Old Fayetteville Road; we have 4 upcoming in Edison Estates; 3 in Meadow Pines and 3 at the old Lighthouse building. We had water breaks on West Apple and Woodland Path and a hydrant hit on South Edison/High Street; the new hatch on the SAVE Site pump station has been installed, we will get that area regraded and hopefully IDOT will let us install a guardrail. Lead and copper sampling is completed and we are waiting for the results; and we are working on replacing a water meter lid for Ace Hardware.

**OLD BUSINESS:** Trustee Matchett said Public Works Director John Tolan advised the committee the pool cover is substantially ripped. Heintz provide a quote of \$18,862 for new cover. Mr. Heintz has a contact with someone that can repair them. John also talked to Mike's Pool and Spa, and Bob is checking 2 others places. John's hope is to be able to repair it. The pool winterization has been completed.

1. E. Drainage Problem Areas/Stormwater Run-Off: Public Works Director John Tolan said the culvert work on Potter and Elizabeth Streets has been completed. Village Administrator Tony Funderburg is concerned about the drainage on Wolf Road. A resident there has equipment ready to dig out an area to make a pond on land that is zoned SR-1. Tony said our zoning code requires a permit for the work that is going to be done. Our responsibility is to make sure the natural flow of water is not changed. Zoning Administrator Matt Trout confirmed the resident received our letter on the 30<sup>th</sup>. We have not heard from the homeowner or engineers. We are prepared to be there to make sure they follow the proper procedure, and the work is done properly. Attorney Keck said we will file an injunction if we need to.
2. Customer Issues: None.
3. MFT:
4. Wolf Road Project: Trustee Matchett said Village Administrator Tony Funderburg advised the committee this is a work in progress, and Oates is going to start looking at available grants. They believe the first step is to try and get Wolf Road classified as a collector street. Oates reported a 5% increase in traffic over the past 4 years. There was some alarming data on the counters for speed.

1. ESDA Motorola Equipment Quote: Trustee Matchett said we have the Motorola Equipment, and this time he would like to make a motion.

2. Status of Sheets' Dog Issue: Trustee Matchett said on the Sheets' dog issue. Chief Schutzenhofer confirmed the fence is up. Attorney Keck said the county doesn't want to take the dogs so installing the fence was a good solution. He further stated Mr. Sheets has provided him with all the proof he requests including pictures and cost of the fence and vaccination records. Mr. Sheets has 7 ordinance violations which could result in 7 different trails at a significant cost. The board needs to decide whether to go to trial or have Attorney Keck negotiate a deal. Trustee Meehling stated she does not see the value of spending more taxpayer money. The committee agreed to have Attorney Keck negotiate the best deal and be finished with this matter

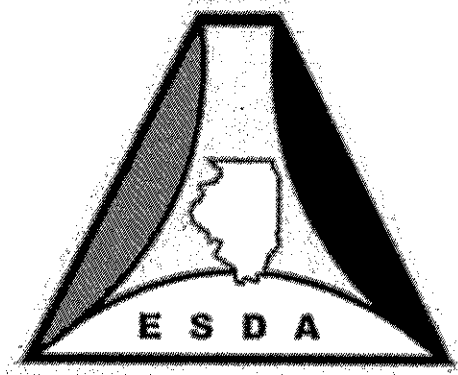

ESDA Report to Mayor and Village Trustees

Nov. 7, 2022

1. Completed training classes from the Storm Prediction Center/FACETS program ,conducted by Ph.D., Makenzie Krocak Oct.19 -20, 2022. The instruction for the selected EMA/ESDA Coordinators was 1 ½ days and not 3 days as originally advised as the main data was conducted on day 1. A group picture of all of us(meteorologists, scientists and EMA/ESDA coordinators was taken on the Webinar classes and this was sent to all last month. The full data summary of the class work can be provided if anyone requests it.
2. The new APX6000 portable radios arrived from Motorola, but the shipment was no complete and the extra batteries and AC desk chargers has been placed on back order and due to arrive mid-December. I am making arrangements with County EMA on the programming per “their network” authorization Talk groups and Zones. These two new portables are for use by the ESDA office and the Mayor.
3. The Outdoor Tornado warning siren system was tested Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> at 10 AM in addition to Communication network of Freeburg ESDA and Region \* IEMA. A retest was required by mid afternoon following an unknown “glitch” of operation by the SAVE site unit, per our Public Works Department personnel on site. The second afternoon activation operated properly. Will monitor this situation to be sure it wasn’t a siren receiver disruption of the transmitted activation signal from the office.

4. NWS office, Meteorologist Ben Herzog, sent data to the Freeburg ESDA office requesting participation in the Winter Preparedness campaign during the month of Nov. 2022 to prepare our community for Winter Hazards. I requested both our local Freeburg Tribune Office and our Office Associate Julie Polson, to see if we can post the supplied “picture preparedness” data from NWS.
5. Follow up work on the office “back up” storage batteries necessary as more current draw noted during bi-weekly test of communications equipment (base station VHF and Starcom unit).
6. Nov. 1, 2022 ARES/RACES amateur radio communications test conducted by support ESDA communications officer, Phil Camerron at 6:30 pm. I was late return from a meeting in St.Louis.

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-17****A RESOLUTION FOR THE FREEBURG CHAMBER OF COMMERCE  
TO SPONSOR A CHRISTMAS LIGHTED PARADE  
IN THE VILLAGE OF FREEBURG**

WHEREAS, the Freeburg Chamber of Commerce is sponsoring a Christmas Lighted Parade in the Village of Freeburg on Sunday, December 4, 2022, which event constitutes a public purpose;

WHEREAS, this parade will require the temporary closure of Route 15 (State Street), a State Highway in the Village of Freeburg from Market Place to Washington Street from 5:00 p.m. – 5:30 p.m.

WHEREAS, Section 4-408 of the Illinois Highway Code authorizes the Department of Transportation to issue permits to local authorities to temporarily close portions of State Highways for such public purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Board of the Village of Freeburg that permission to close off State Street from Market Place to Washington Street, as above designated, be requested of the Department of Transportation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this closure shall occur during the approximate time period between 5:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. on Sunday, December 4, 2022.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that traffic from that closed portion of highway shall be detoured over routes with an all-weather surface that can accept the anticipated traffic, which will be maintained to the satisfaction of the Department and which is conspicuously marked for the benefit of traffic diverted from the State highway. (The parking of vehicles shall be prohibited on the detour routes to allow an uninterrupted flow of two-way traffic.) The detour route shall be as follows:

North State Street, From Market Place Drive South to W. Washington Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Village of Freeburg assumes full responsibility for the direction, protection, and regulation of the traffic during the time the detour is in effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that police officers or authorized flaggers shall, at the expense of the Village of Freeburg, be positioned at each end of the closed section and at other points (such as intersections) as may be necessary to assist in directing traffic through the detour.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that police officers, flaggers and officials shall permit emergency vehicles in emergency situations to pass through the closed area as swiftly as is safe for all concerned.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all debris shall be removed by the Village of Freeburg prior to reopening the State highway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such signs, flags, barricades, etc., shall be used by the Village of Freeburg as may be approved by the Illinois Department of Transportation. These items shall be provided by the Village of Freeburg.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the closure and detour shall be marked according to the Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-17 cont.**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, an occasional break shall be made in the procession so that traffic may pass through. In any event, adequate provisions will be made for traffic on intersecting highways pursuant to conditions above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that to the fullest extent permitted by law, the Village of Freeburg shall be responsible for any and all injuries to persons or damages to property, and shall indemnify and hold harmless the Illinois Department of Transportation, its officers, employees and agents from any and all claims, lawsuits, actions, costs and fees (including reasonable attorneys' fees and expenses) of every nature or description, arising out of, resulting from or connected with the exercise of authority granted by the Department which is the subject of this resolution. The obligation is binding upon the Village of Freeburg regardless of whether or not such claim, damage, loss or expense is caused in part by the act, omission or negligence

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Village of Freeburg shall provide a comprehensive general liability policy or an additional named insured endorsement in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000 per person and \$2,000,00 aggregate which has the Illinois Department of Transportation, its officials, employees and agents as insureds and which protects them from all claims arising from the requested road closing. A copy of said policy or endorsement will be provided to the Department before the road is closed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Department of Transportation, District 8, to serve as a formal request for the permission sought in this Resolution and to operate as part of the conditions of said permission.

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the Village that the taxes heretofore levied for the year 2022 to pay the Bonds be abated:

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It and It is Hereby Resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Freeburg, St. Clair County, Illinois, as follows:

*Section 1. Abatement of Taxes.* The taxes heretofore levied for the year 2022 in the Ordinance are hereby abated in their entirety, see Exhibit A attached.

*Section 2. Filing of Ordinance.* Forthwith upon the adoption of this ordinance, the Village Clerk of the Board of Trustees shall file a certified copy hereof with the County Clerk and it shall be the duty of the County Clerk to abate said taxes levied for the year 2022 in accordance with the provisions hereof.

*Section 3. Effective Date.* This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption.

**ORDINANCE NO. 1756****AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF FREEBURG, ILLINOIS  
DISSOLVING THE SPECIAL TAX ALLOCATION FUND AND  
TERMINATING THE DESIGNATION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT  
PROJECT AREA WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF FREEBURG**

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board of the Village of Freeburg, Illinois, on December 6, 2004, adopted Ordinance Number 1163, which adopted tax increment financing, established a special tax allocation fund and approved and adopted a redevelopment plan and project for the the North State Street area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Freeburg previously has notified the affected taxing districts of the proposed termination of the Redevelopment Project Area in accordance with the provisions of the Tax Increment Allocation Redevelopment Act (65 ILCS 5/11-74.4-1, et seq.), as supplemented and amended; and

**WHEREAS**, with respect to the Redevelopment Project Area, provisions have been made or will be made prior to December 31, 2022, to create an escrow account and to transfer certain amounts from the Fund to the Escrow Account for any amounts due and payable by the Village of Freeburg; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with the terms of the Tax Increment Allocation Redevelopment Act, the Village will pay all redevelopment costs will be paid, any obligations will be paid and retired, and all excess monies will be distributed as of December 31, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Freeburg desires to dissolve the special tax allocation fund relating to the Redevelopment Project Area, and to terminate the designation of the Redevelopment Project as a redevelopment project area.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Freeburg, St. Clair County, Illinois as follows:

1. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
2. The Fund established in regard to the Redevelopment Project Area is hereby dissolved as of December 31, 2022.
3. The designation of the Redevelopment Project Area as a redevelopment project area is hereby terminated as of December 31, 2022.
4. Amounts remaining in the escrow, if any, shall be paid to the County Collector who shall distribute such amounts to the respective taxing districts in the Redevelopment Project Area in the same manner and proportion as the applicable distribution by the County Collector to the affected taxing districts of real property taxes from the Redevelopment Project Area.

**SECTION 1.** That the amount hereinafter set forth based on \$104,500,000 EAV, or so much thereof as may be authorized by law, and the same are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the municipality as that property is assessed and equalized for the current year, and for such purposes as: General Corporate, Audit, Police Protection, Civil Defense (Emergency Services Disaster Agency), and Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund (IMRF), for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2022, and ending March 31, 2023.

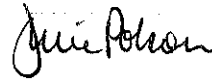
### B. NEW BUSINESS:

### PERSONNEL AND PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING (Meehling/Blaies/Heap/Matchett) Wednesday, October 26, 2022 at 6:00 p.m.

Acting Chairperson Mike Blaies called the meeting of the Personnel and Public Safety Committee to order on Wednesday, October 26, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. Those present were Chairperson Lisa Meehling, Trustee Mike Blaies, Trustee Mike Heap, Trustee Ray Matchett, Mayor Seth Speiser (absent), Village Clerk Jerry Menard, Trustee Denise Albers, Trustee Bob Kaiser, Village Attorney Fred Keck, Chief Mike Schutzenhofer, Public Works Director John Tolan, Zoning Administrator Matt Trout, Village Administrator Tony Funderburg and Office Manager Julie Polson. Guest present: Janet Baechle (left at 6:24 p.m.). There were no guests present via Zoom.

#### **POLICE:**

**A. OLD BUSINESS:** Chief Mike Schutzenhofer summarized the calls over the last month. He attended a meeting in Edwardsville and met with Senator Kris Tharp and approximately 50 other police chiefs regarding the new Safety Act. Mike stated it was a good meeting, and Senator Tharp is hoping to get a plan together to get things corrected. Other counties have filed lawsuits regarding the Safety Act on the basis that it is unconstitutional.

**B. NEW BUSINESS:** Mike has three outdated computers/tablets from 2015 that have Windows 7 as the operating system, and another one that has died. He obtained a quote from Computron of \$15,595 for four computers and docking stations. He would like to use the remaining funds from the citizen that donated money to the Police Department in the amount of \$4,496. He would like to use the golf tournament proceeds for the remainder. He does not know the installation and configuration costs. The other tablets we have are 3 - 4 years old and have Windows 10. He did not include these in his budget. Attorney Keck advised since Computron is our provider and offers specialized technology, we can waive the 2/3's bidding requirement. Village Administrator Tony Funderburg said we need to include these items in our 3 - 5 year plan. He also wants a plan to track the golf tournament revenues, expenses and profits. He further commented we can get all the money in the world but if you don't appropriate it, you can't spend it. Trustee Meehling stated we need a plan to replace the remaining tablets.
