#### FINANCE:

Trustee (Chairperson) Denise Albers reported on the Finance Committee Meeting held on Wednesday, April 28, 2021 at 5:30 p.m.

**1. REVISE OF BOARD LISTS:** Trustee Albers said we reviewed the Board List in our Finance Committee meeting. Trustee Albers said on the board lists there were some questions: Municipal Equipment \$5,114.13 this was for two high tide alarms we installed on the Pitts and N. Edison lift stations; Bel-O-Man, \$1,605.14 this was for the ambient control that was installed to help the heat pump switch ; Midwest Underground, \$3,720 there was an issue at the Palomar lift station and had to have camera to find the problem; Omnigo Software \$17,806.88 we had to upgrade our system with digit ticket and become complaint with the mandates; \$3,490 too repair leaks at the S.A.V.E. site standpipe.

**2. REVIEW OF INVESTMENTS:** Trustee Albers said we have nothing due until October 2021. The funds continue to sit in the money market account.

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3. **INCOME STATEMENT:** Trustee Albers said Chief Schutzenhofer confirmed the \$18,722.62 expense in other professional services was for the CENCOM agreement. In electric, the \$7,398 expense under infrastructure was for breaker repair.

2. Newsletter: Trustee Albers said the news letter went out 2 weeks ago and there is nothing new at this time.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

1. CAT Generator Control System Upgrade: Trustee Albers said we did discuss the proposal for the CAT Generator Control System upgrades. This upgrade will run close to \$4,000. Our generators are aging and trying to find parts to replace is becoming an issue. Our electric bonds will be paid off in 2025 and these payments run between \$360,000 - \$395,000. Trustee Albers said she doesn't feel comfortable waiting on this, Public Works Director John Tolan recommended we do this. Finance rates are low right now. It would be more costly if we go down and lose our IMEA credits. The committee recommended Village Administrator Tony Funderburg to work with Treasurer Bryan Vogel on getting information on financing this project. If we move forward with this and the board agrees to do the entire project at once, we will try to schedule this in the fall. We will discuss this at the next Electric committee meeting.

2. Loans for Police and Public Works Vehicles: Trustee Albers said we discussed the financing of the police and public works vehicles. Trustee Albers said Treasurer Vogel provided an informal loan quote from Citizens Bank at 1.5% for the vehicles. The committee did ask Treasurer Vogel to check with Bank of Belleville and First National Bank of Waterloo for bids.

3. Waste Management: Trustee Albers said Village Administrator Tony Funderburg provided us with two proposals from Waste Management for our trash and recycling renewal. They range in price from \$14 - \$20 per month for residents. We are going to have a Committee As A Whole meeting to discuss the renewal in depth, and at that time we will also include RFQs.

4. 2021 MFT Bids: Trustee Albers said Village Administrator Funderburg advised the committee Beelman and Don Anderson were the low bids.

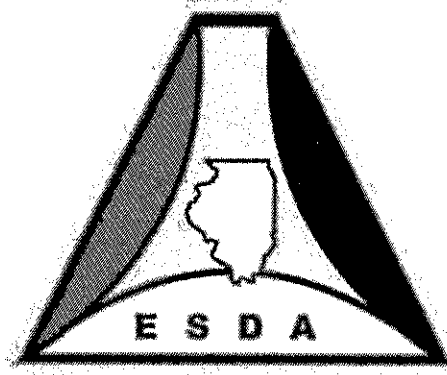

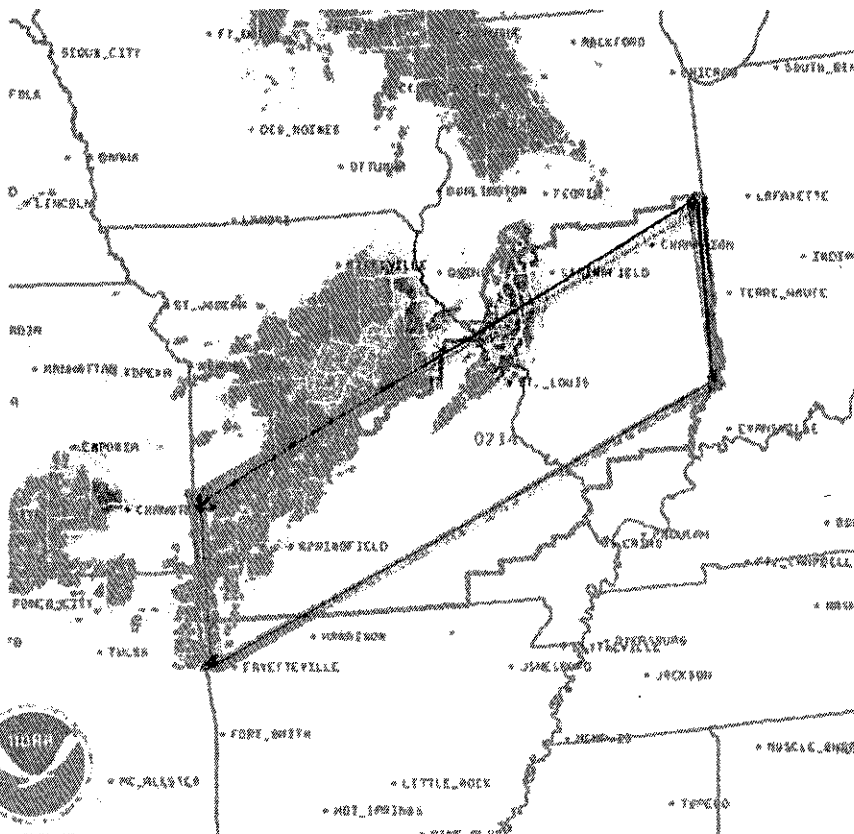

I continue to send out letters, make phone calls, and follow up on letters sent out to properties that are in violation. I have made contact with several people about mowing their properties. For the most part those people have done so. The Village has mowed a property on 5/14/21 and may be forced to mow the property again. This home is in foreclosure and the reality company cannot get permission from the lender to mow. The foreclosure company paid the amount prior to the lien being placed.

Bill's Automotive located at 410 N State St has removed 20-25 cars from the property. This has been a work in progress for many years and we are very happy to see movement forward with the property. Dori Marine has also been put up for sale and I have been working with the son and a realtor to get the rest of the property cleaned up.

The contractor has been out at Edison Estates planting vegetation and doing work on the property. The two homes being built are coming along nicely. We do have a variance hearing set for July 6<sup>th</sup> at 5:45. They have an issue fitting their villas on 4 of the lots around the cul de sac and are requesting a front setback variance from 25' to 15' for those 4 villas lots.

**ORDINANCE NO. 1713****AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1 – ADMINISTRATION – ARTICLE II – VILLAGE OFFICIALS - DIVISION XII – VILLAGE ENGINEER – OF THE REVISED CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF FREEBURG, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

**WHEREAS**, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Freeburg, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Freeburg, Illinois, has reviewed the provisions of the current text of Chapter 1 – Administration – Article II – Village Officials – Division XII – Village Engineer of the Code of Ordinances and determined that it requires certain amendments to conform with current operational practices; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Freeburg, Illinois, believes it is beneficial to the citizens of the Village of Freeburg, Illinois, to amend Chapter 1 – Administration – Article II – Village Officials – Division XII – Village Engineer of the Code of Ordinances accordingly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF FREEBURG, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:

- Section 1. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
- Section 2. Chapter 1 – Administration – Article II – Village Officials – Division XII – Village Engineer is hereby AMENDED as follows:

Chapter I. ADMINISTRATION

Article II – Village Officials

Division XII – Village Engineer(s)

- **1-2-135. - APPOINTMENT.**

With the advice and consent of the Village Board, the Mayor may appoint engineer(s) for the Village, who shall serve for the term of the Mayor or for such period not exceeding the term of the Mayor, as may be designated by the Mayor and Village Board.

• **1-2-136. - DUTIES—SALARY.**

The so designated Village Engineer(s) shall make and submit plans, estimates and specifications for public work which may be proposed or ordered by the Village Board. The Engineer(s) shall also examine all public works under their charge and see that the plans, estimates and specifications for same are properly executed. The Engineer(s) shall receive reasonable compensation for their services and the same will be provided for in the annual appropriation ordinance on an estimated basis.

**State Law reference—** See 65 ILCS § 5/3.1-30-5.

• **1-2-137—1-2-139. - RESERVED.**

Section 3: That all other provisions of Chapter 1 of the Code of Ordinances shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect except as specifically amended by this Ordinance.

Section 4: If any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections or provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid section or provision, and to this end, the sections and provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, signing and publication as required by law.
