Chairman Ray Matchett officially called the meeting of the Finance Committee to order at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 27, 2016. Those in attendance were Chairperson Ray Matchett, Trustee Denise Albers, Trustee Lisa Meehling, Trustee Matt Trout, Mayor Seth Speiser, Treasurer Bryan Vogel, Trustee Mike Blaies, Trustee Dean Pruett, Village Clerk Jerry Menard, Public Works Director John Tolan, Village Administrator Tony Funderburg, Finance Clerk Debbie Pierce and Office Manager Julie Polson. Guest present: Janet Baechle.

A. REVIEW OF BOARD LISTS: The Board Lists were reviewed by the committee. Trustee Trout asked about the money given to the schools, and Julie advised when the recycling center was started, we told the schools we wouldn't take any of that revenue from them. We split any money received for the paper recycling between St. Joe's, and the grade and high schools equally.

B. REVIEW OF INVESTMENTS: Nothing new.

C. INCOME STATEMENT: Finance Clerk Debbie Pierce said some of the items charged in April will be backed out and put into march for the electric, water and sewer funds.

C. TREASURER'S REPORT: Treasurer Vogel had nothing new to report.

E. OLD BUSINESS:

1. Approval of March 30, 2016 Minutes. Trustee Matt Trout motioned to approve the March 30, 2016 minutes and Trustee Lisa Meehling seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.
2. Attorney Invoices: No questions.
3. Sign at Industrial Park: Public Works Director John Tolan stated the holes are getting augered tomorrow and the concrete will be poured on Friday. The first sign will be done within next couple of weeks. Tony advised the high point of the sign will be towards the road. Tony said we decided to put 10 panels on the first sign for the businesses. John advised Jerry is already building the second sign.
4. 3-to-5 year plan/Strategic Plan/Spreadsheet of Agreements: Tony is going to add working on the water mains in front of the high school. He and John will work on a plan to see if there's a way to get better water pressure up front. Item will be taken off the agenda. When Tony has an addition, he will email it to everyone.

5. Newsletter: Tony said we need people to give us events. Trustee Trout would like to keep this on the agenda. The next newsletter will encompass July, August and September.

F. NEW BUSINESS:

1. Pool Equipment: Tony found the exact same slide for \$18,401.00 delivered. Jerod Heintz helped out, and said we can install it. Tony said the only issue is the directional bore. If we can't do it, there would be an additional \$1,000 to have that done. He would like it placed on Monday's agenda for approval. Trustee Meehling asked if there will be a warranty issue if we install ourself. Tony said we would need a stamped architectural drawing, and EWR can do that for \$300. Mr. Heintz advised Tony if we have any issues, his guys will come over and help us out. He told Tony it's a great slide and asset to the pool.

Trustee Lisa Meehling motioned to recommend to the full Board the purchase of a Vortex Slide at a cost of \$18,401.76 and Trustee Matt Trout seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.

Tony advised when the access control representative visited Village Hall, he advised since we have a fire protection system, they need to install something in order to tie it into that system which will cost an extra \$1,700. Trustee Trout asked if the other bids had that, and Tony advised they were stated as a separate cost. The committee agreed to the additional \$1,700.00 for the access system.

With respect to running fiber between our buildings, Tony had a meeting with our phone company and IT company. They recommend using Charter which has a program for municipalities to take fiber underground at a cost of \$450/mo. Once we bring service in here, Tony said we can eliminate all our other stuff. We will have one internet that will serve all of our buildings including the pool and sewer plant. There will be no cost to run the fiber to our building, and we will receive 13 static ips which is a good deal for us. He would like to put the contract on the board agenda. Trustee Blaies asked the length of the contract, and Tony believes it is a month-to-month contract. Tony will review the contract to verify that. The static IP addresses are a secure link that both our police department and power plant need. We will have one for our phone system so they won't need to come out when it goes down. John advised this will improve our system reliability. The committee agreed for Tony to move forward with this.

G. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION: Janet asked about the slide and if the \$1,000 should have been included in the price. Tony said we have authority to approve anything under \$5,000.

H. ADJOURN: *Trustee Matt Trout motioned to adjourn the meeting at 6:20 p.m. and Trustee Lisa Meehling seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.*





Report to Mayor and Village Board Trustees

May 2, 2016

Freeburg ESDA Office alerted to five (5) Severe Weather alert events between April 26-27. One Severe thunderstorm Watch and four "related" Severe Thunderstorm Warnings, fortunately only one that included the Freeburg Area. NWS continues the excellent job and with the use of our WeatherTap radar subscription, cross hatching of the "warned area" assisted in determining when Freeburg was or was not in the warning area. St. Paul's UCC shelter opened by ESDA Shelter Manager Janet B. during the one affected warning for the Freeburg area. Summary of events:

- Severe Thunderstorm Watch issued by SPC included all of St. Clair Co. 4/26/16 4:41 PM valid to 7 PM.
- Severe thunderstorm warning issued by NWS St. Louis- 2 PM – 3:45 PM (extreme NW area).
- Severe Thunderstorm warning issued by NWS St. Louis – 2:27 PM – 3:15 PM (Freeburg area).
- Severe Thunderstorm warning issued by NWS St. Louis – 3:00 pm- 3:45 PM –far Eastern Co.)

During the severe thunderstorm watch and warning period, maintained VHF radio communications on the District 70/77 school frequency that we have an LMOU to operate with them. Due to expected winds in excess of 60 mph and large hail with extremely low visibility due to heavy rainfall, school buses delayed departure of transport of students based on our time based data of storm cell movement.

II. During the communications with School Districts 70 & 77 , the ESDA office was advised that their Weather Alert radios did not activate. On April 27th, I responded to review the issue and two receivers at the Grade School required reprogramming to affect its proper operation and the High School required reprogramming as well, but a concern still exists on its "internal" DC connection switching. I will maintain contact with them as NWS performs weekly "alert" tests every Wednesday. If any issues arise, I will replace this unit and access potential repairs.

III. I am working on the Village ESDA EOP for updates and revision information to place on thumbdrive and/or update on present CD listing. Will send to all departments for review as getting everyone


together for a meeting had to be postponed and looking for reschedule date(s). This method should make the upcoming meeting more effective and efficient.

IV. Telephone contact with Federal Sign and Signal Corp. representative Bruce Fisher, as Mr. Fisher called to explain the quote concerning the projected purchase of their "Eclipse" model outdoor warning siren that we are looking to install at the SAVE site. Information presented to Public Safety meeting on 4/27/16. Provided information to committee especially as it concerned the "battery back up" availability which was not available when the original siren system was installed in 1976 and again in 2001.

V. National Weather Service WCM James Kramper, sent to all EMA/ESDA offices, information whereby their office will offer a "long range" projected weather forecast to cover any LARGE SCALE City/Village events that involve the "outdoor activities" of Fairs, Homecomings, etc., where there may be large (in excess of 100 or more persons) outside attendance. As the event time becomes closer, the forecast becomes more refined and if there are any issues with severe weather on the "target activity date", their office will call our office to keep us advised of this situation. This really impacts events like the St. Louis Fair, RACE for Cures events, etc. However, our Freeburg Homecoming "qualifies" as well. So I will provide our homecoming date/time to his office to be placed in this project.



ANNEXATION AGREEMENT

THIS ANNEXATION AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made and entered into this ____ day of _____, 2016, by and between Randal Harms, 6355 Countryside Lane, Freeburg, Illinois, (hereinafter referred to as "Owner") and the VILLAGE OF FREEBURG ("Village"), a municipal corporation organization and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Illinois by and through its Mayor and Village Trustees (collectively, "Corporate Authorities").

RECITALS

A. Owner is the owner of record of certain parcels of real property situated in St. Clair County, Illinois, which are adjacent to the Village and are more particularly described in Exhibit "A," the legal description, attached hereto and made a part hereof (the "Parcels").

B. The Parcels consist of approximately 15.89 acres and adjoin, abuts, and are contiguous to the corporate limits of the Village.

C. The Parcels have not been annexed to any municipality and are currently situated within unincorporated St. Clair County, Illinois.

D. The Parcels constitute territory that is contiguous to and may be annexed to the Village, as provided under Section 7-1-1, *et seq.*, of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/7-1-1, *et seq.*

E. Owner desires to have the Parcels annexed to the Village, on the terms and conditions provided herein and to qualify for such benefits or services as such annexation may so entitle it.

F. The Corporate Authorities, after due and careful consideration, have concluded that the annexation of the Parcels to the Village would further the orderly growth of the Village, enable the Village to control the development of the Parcels, and serve the best interests of the Village.

G. Pursuant to the provisions of 65 ILCS 5/11-15.1-1, *et seq.*, a proposed Annexation Agreement, in substance and form the same as this Agreement, was submitted to the Corporate Authorities and a public hearing was held on _____ pursuant to notice, all as provided by statute and the ordinances of the Village.

H. Any fire protection district, library district and other entity or person entitled to notice prior to annexation of the Parcels to the Village have been given notice thereof by the Village as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, and in compliance with ordinances, codes, and regulations of the Village in effect as of the date of this Agreement, or as may hereinafter be enacted, subsequently, the Parties hereto hereby agree as follows:

1. **Statutory Authority.** The Parties hereto enter into this Agreement pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of 65 ILCS 5/11-15.1-1, *et seq.*

2. **Annexation.**

- a) Concurrent with this Agreement, Owner has filed with the Village Clerk a Petition for Annexation of the Parcels to the Village, conditioned on the terms and provisions of this Agreement, which petition has been prepared, executed and filed in accordance with 65 ILCS 5/7-1-8, and the ordinances and other requirements of the Village. A copy of said Petition is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "B."
- b) Owner has filed with the Village Clerk a Plat of Annexation which contains an accurate map of the Parcels, illustrated with the zoning district(s) Owner are seeking as a condition of annexation, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "C" ("Annexation Plat").
- c) Subject to the terms of this Agreement, the Corporate Authorities shall hereinafter enact an ordinance annexing the Parcels to the Village ("Annexation Ordinance") which ordinance shall attach the Annexation Plat.

3. **Rezoning.** Upon the Effective Date of the Annexation Ordinance as set forth herein, the Village shall do the following:

- a) The Village shall adopt an ordinance zoning and classifying the Parcels as follows: "A"(Agricultural Use). The Parties acknowledge that prior to the effective date and execution of this Agreement, such public hearings as are necessary to enable the Village lawfully to grant said zoning classification as to the Parcels will have been conducted upon proper notice.
- b) Except as provided herein, all future changes in land use or related activity on the Parcels, if any, shall be subject to the applicable ordinances and laws authorizing or regulating such change or activity now in effect or as amended from time to time.

4. **Water Supply/Sanitary Sewer/Electrical Service.**

- a) The Village agrees to allow the Owner to connect to the Village water system and to make that utility reasonably available to the Parcel. The Village agrees to extend a municipal water main to that area for the purpose of using said system to serve the Owner's primary residence only, via a private water line constructed by the Village from the Parcels to the municipal water main. Said private water line construction shall comply with all standards set by the Village, and Village's Engineer of Record, IEPA, the American Water Works

Association Standards of Denver, Colorado as amended from time to time, and/or other state, federal or local regulatory agencies in effect as of the date of this agreement, and further provided the Village bears all costs related to construction of the private line including, but not limited to, cost of labor, material, design and engineering and easement acquisition. One water tap-on fee will be waived provided the owner connects to the water utility within one year of that utility service becoming available to the Parcels.

In the event that it is determined that the Village is prohibited from extending a municipal water main to the Parcel, Owner shall have 90 days from notice of the prohibition to terminate this agreement and to file a petition to disconnect and the Village shall consent to the petition to disconnect.

- b) During the term of this Agreement, the Village agrees to allow the Owner to connect to the Village sanitary sewer system at Owner's option and Owner's expense, if and when sanitary sewer service becomes available to the Parcels. Upon expiration of this Agreement, Owner's connection obligations shall be governed by the applicable Village ordinances and policies. Any conflicting federal or state laws governing sanitary sewer connection shall supersede this paragraph.
- c) During the term of this Agreement, the Village agrees to allow the Owner to connect to the Village electric system at Owner's option and Owner's expense, if and when electric service becomes available to the Parcels. Upon expiration of this Agreement, Owner's connection obligations shall be governed by the applicable Village ordinances and policies. Any conflicting federal or state laws governing electric system connection shall supersede this paragraph.
- d) The Village shall not be held responsible for its inability to install any utility, or for any loss or damage including consequential damage, or delay in installation, caused by strikes, riots, elements, embargoes, failure of carriers, inability to obtain material, or other acts of God, or any other cause beyond Village's reasonable control, including but not limited to the acquisition of easements, modifications of Facilities Planning Area boundaries, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency permits or any other governmental or regulatory permit or approval.

5. **Subdivision/Dedication of Improvements.**

- a) In the event the Owner subdivides or otherwise develops the Parcels, the Owner shall dedicate to the Village, the roadways, the public improvements, the water lines, sanitary sewers and the storm sewers by recording with the St. Clair County, Illinois Recorder, in a form acceptable to the Village, the appropriate subdivision plat which dedicates the public improvements as

provided herein. Nothing herein shall require the Village to accept such improvements for maintenance or liability that are not in satisfaction of the Village's specifications or that have not been inspected, approved and accepted by the Village.

- b) The Owner shall grant to the Village nonexclusive utility easements ("Utility Easements") for maintenance and repair of the aforesaid utilities to be constructed on the Parcels and dedicated to the Village as shown on the Final Plat, and any other easements the Village may reasonably require for municipal purposes.
- c) The Owner shall pay all development fees including but not limited to green space fees, plat review fees, completion and maintenance security for dedicated public improvements and normal and customary building permits, relative to development of the Parcels as set forth in the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Freeburg, as amended from time to time.

6. **Miscellaneous.**

- a) Notwithstanding any other provision contained herein to the contrary, with respect to the Parcels, this Agreement shall be effective for a term of ten (10) years from the date hereof, provided that any continuing obligations to the Village shall survive any termination or expiration to the extent consistent with 65 ILCS 5/11-15.1-1.
- b) This Agreement shall bind the heirs, successors, and assigns of the Owner, the Village, the Corporate Authorities and their successors in office. This Agreement shall inure to the benefit of the Parties hereof, their successors and assigns. This Agreement and the obligations of Owner hereunder shall be a covenant that shall run with the land, shall be a provision of any sale or other contract for transfer of interest in the Parcels, and may be recorded. Upon annexation, Owner shall comply with all ordinances of the Village, as adopted or amended from time to time.
- c) Nothing herein shall in any way prevent the alienation, encumbrance or sale of the Parcels or any portion thereof, and the new owner shall be both benefited and bound by the conditions and restrictions herein expressed.
- d) Within thirty (30) days after the passage, approval and adoption of an ordinance of annexation by the Village, the text of this Agreement (or a suitable memorandum hereof) shall be recorded at the sole cost and expense of the Village in the Office of the Recorder of St. Clair County, Illinois.
- e) Except as otherwise expressly provided herein, Owner shall comply in all respects with the applicable provisions of the Village of Freeburg Municipal

Code, whether or not any of such ordinances are amended after the date hereof.

- f) It is further agreed that any party to this Agreement, either in law or in equity, by suit, action, mandamus or other proceeding may enforce or compel the performance of this Agreement, or have other such relief for the breach thereof as may be authorized by law or that by law or in equity is available to them.
- g) It is understood by the Parties hereto that time is of the essence. It is further understood that upon the occurrence of a default of any of the provisions of this Agreement, which default continues for ten (10) days after a notice specifying such default is given the defaulting party, the injured party hereto may in law or in equity, by suit, action, mandamus or other proceeding, including specific performance, enforce or compel the performance of this Agreement by such defaulting party.
- h) The undersigned persons, whether signing individually, on behalf of a municipal corporation, or by an attorney-in-fact warrant themselves: (i) to be of lawful age, (ii) to be legally competent to execute this Agreement, (iii) to be fully authorized to execute this Agreement on behalf of themselves or the municipal corporation or other entity indicated below, and (iv) to have signed this Agreement on their own behalf or on behalf of such municipal corporation or other entity as their own free acts and deeds and/or the free acts and deeds of such municipal corporation or other entity after opportunity to consult with legal counsel.
- i) In the event any portion of this Agreement or part thereof shall be deemed invalid, such invalidity of said provision or part thereof shall not affect the validity of any other provision hereof.
- j) Unless stated otherwise herein, any notice required or permitted under this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be deemed given when mailed by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, to the respective parties at their addresses listed below:

ORDINANCE NO. 1583**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FREEBURG ZONING ORDINANCE
FOR THE PURPOSE OF REZONING CERTAIN PROPERTY
COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE HARMS PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Freeburg, St. Clair County, State of Illinois, presently has in force The Freeburg Zoning Ordinance, which is contained in the Freeburg Municipal Code, as amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Village Plan Commission has complied with the provisions of 65 ILCS 5/11-13-14 and Article 40-23-1 of the Freeburg Zoning Ordinance regarding amendments of regulations and zoning districts by holding a public hearing on April 26, 2016 to consider the request for a rezoning of certain property owned by Randal Harms, pursuant to notice as required by statute; and

WHEREAS, the property owner of certain property commonly known as the Harms Property consisting of 15.89 acres in the Village of Freeburg, Illinois have filed an application for rezoning the Property from SR-1 to A (Agricultural);

WHEREAS, the map attached hereto, marked Exhibit A, is an accurate map of the property so sought to be rezoned and such rezoning shall be in accordance with the boundaries indicated on the map;

WHEREAS, as a result of said hearing, the Plan Commission has made a recommendation to the Village Board that it approve the request for rezoning to A;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has considered the recommendation of the Plan Commission and has determined that it is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare and in compliance with the powers conferred upon the Village and the objectives and purposes set out in 65 ILCS 5/11-13-1, to adopt an amendment to the Freeburg Zoning Ordinance for the purpose of rezoning the Harms Property to allow A uses in accordance with the map attached hereto as Exhibit A; and





