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PERSONNEL AND PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING (Meehling/Blaies/Heap/Matchett) Wednesday, January 26, 2022 at 6:00 p.m.

Chairperson Lisa Meehling called the meeting of the Personnel and Public Safety Committee to order on Wednesday, January 26, 2022 at 6:29 p.m. Those present were Chairperson Lisa Meehling, Trustee Mike Blaies, Trustee Mike Heap, Trustee Ray Matchett, Mayor Seth Speiser, Village Clerk Jerry Menard, Trustee Denise Albers, Trustee Bob Kaiser, Village Attorney Fred Keck, Chief Mike Schutzenhofer, Public Works Director John Tolan, Zoning Administrator Matt Trout, Village Administrator Tony Funderburg and Office Manager Julie Polson. Guest present: Wavey Lester, Republican Candidate for Senate and Janet Baechle.

POLICE:

A. OLD BUSINESS:

1. School Resource Officer for Freeburg High School: Village Administrator Tony Funderburg stated we are working to receive a waiver from the state. We do not have a contract in place, and the officer at the school is not a school resource officer at this time. Once we have the waiver, we can then look at preparing a contract to present to the school. Chief Mike Schutzenhofer said our officer at the high school is signed up for the national SRO training program on February 14th.
2. Lexipol Program: Tony approved the start of this program at a cost of \$1,300 for the next 4 months. After that, the yearly cost for the program will be \$5,400. This program will keep our officers current on the ever-changing laws. Attorney Keck commented almost every town he knows is doing this. Our officers will be as up to date as they can be.

B. NEW BUSINESS:

1. Part-Time Police Officer Hire: Mike stated the officer he had in mind accepted another job yesterday. He believes with the officers that were shot today it will be hard to find them. The committee discussed putting part-time officers in the union contract.

PERSONNEL:

A. OLD BUSINESS:

1. Approval of December 29, 2021 Minutes: Trustee Mike Blaies motioned to approve the December 29, 2021 Minutes and Trustee Ray Matchett seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.
2. Vaccine Mandate: Item can be taken off the agenda.

B. NEW BUSINESS:

1. Payout of Accumulated Compensatory Time for Police and Public Works Employees: Tony advised the union contracts limit the amount of compensatory time that can be carried over from year to year to 40 hours, and that 240 hours is the total that can be accumulated.


Trustee Ray Matchett motioned to recommend to the full Board the payout of compensatory time for the public works and police employees per the spreadsheets, and also Shane Krauss' request to be paid for 100 hours of compensatory time, and Trustee Mike Blaies seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.

2. Lifeguard Hires: *Trustee Ray Matchett motioned to recommend to the full Board Greta Schulz be hired as a lifeguard for the 2022 pool season at a rate of \$12.00 per hour, and Trustee Mike Heap seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.*
