## PERSONNEL AND PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING (Meehling/Blaies/Heap/Matchett) Wednesday, June 30, 2021 at 6:00 p.m.

Chairperson Lisa Meehling called the meeting of the Personnel and Public Safety Committee to order on Wednesday, May 26, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. via the Zoom Application. Those present were Chairperson Lisa Meehling, Trustee Mike Blaies, Trustee Mike Heap, Trustee Ray Matchett, Mayor Seth Speiser, Village Clerk Jerry Menard (absent), Trustee Denise Albers, Trustee Bob Kaiser, Village Attorney Fred Keck (absent), Chief Mike Schutzenhofer, Public Works Director John Tolan, Zoning Administrator Matt Trout, Village Administrator Tony Funderburg (absent) and Office Manager Julie Polson (absent). Guest present: Janet Baechle. There were no guests present via Zoom.

### POLICE:

**A. OLD BUSINESS:** None.

### B. NEW BUSINESS:

1. Stop sign request at Apple St./Vine St.: The committee discussed the request. John advised we have a stop sign a block up at Cherry St., and agreed another one in that area was needed.
2. Resolution #21-07: A Resolution Authorizing the Village to Enter into and the Chief of Police to Execute an Intergovernmental Agreement between the Village and Metropolitan Enforcement Group of Southwestern Illinois: Chief Schutzenhofer advised we have 3 agents that live in town, and whenever he calls MEGSI, they are here.

*Trustee Mike Blaies motioned to recommend to the full Board Resolution #21-07, A Resolution Authorizing the Village to Enter into and the Chief of Police to Execute an Intergovernmental Agreement between the Village and Metropolitan Enforcement Group of Southwestern Illinois for approval and Trustee Ray Matchett seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.*

3. Officer Terry Marquardt Appointment as Deputy Director of the Metro East Auto Theft Task Force: Chief Schutzenhofer said Terry is now second in charge. Terry has been doing a great job and will continue with the task force with the added responsibilities.

Mike received an email from Dave Fellows advising of an agency looking for used cars. He spoke with them and we could get rid of our two part-time police officers' cars. He would remove the computers, radios, and camera systems and decals. He will coordinate the removal of the cars with the delivery of our new ones.


Mayor Speiser advised he and Tony have met with Attorney Keck on the union contracts. We are working on a time to meet with the union representative.
