PERSONNEL AND PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING (Meehling/Blaies/Heap/Matchett) Wednesday, August 25, 2021 at 6:00 p.m.

Acting Chairperson Ray Matchett called the meeting of the Personnel and Public Safety Committee to order on Wednesday, August 25, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. Those present were Acting Chairperson Ray Matchett, Trustee Mike Blaies, Trustee Mike Heap, Trustee Lisa Meehling, Mayor Seth Speiser, Village Clerk Jerry Menard (absent), Trustee Denise Albers, Trustee Bob Kaiser, Village Attorney Fred Keck, Chief Mike Schutzenhofer (absent), Public Works Director John Tolan, Zoning Administrator Matt Trout, Village Administrator Tony Funderburg and Office Manager Julie Polson. Guest present: Janet Baechle. Guest present via Zoom: Max Sallman (6:09 p.m.).

POLICE:

A. OLD BUSINESS: None.

B. NEW BUSINESS:

1. Alliance Against Intoxicated Motorists Certificate of Appreciation for Officers Joel Boeing, Jacob Hoffman, Tyler Howes and Clayton Proffitt: These officers were recognized for their exceptional efforts against DUIs.

Village Administrator Tony Funderburg presented Chief Schutzenhofer's proposal to use the golf fundraiser proceeds to purchase four new moving radar units and also hand guns and mags at a total cost of \$11,314.75. Attorney Keck is fine with the firearms. He would like documentation from the union indicating they are agreeable to our officers using them. Our officers don't currently have the same caliber firearm, and Attorney Keck believes they should. It was agreed that funding for the firearms won't happen unless the officers agree to sign off on using the firearm we issue.

Tony advised memos have been distributed to the Admin, Public Works and Police Departments regarding the Village of Freeburg's COVID-19 protocol. It explained FFCRA is over, employees have to use sick or compensatory time when off work, wear masks when appropriate and stay 6 feet apart. Tony commented we are seeing other police departments and municipalities shutting down. There has to be some personal responsibility for this and reiterated the need to wear a mask if needed. Tony said it is the employee's right to figure this out with their doctor.
