UTILITY BILL INFO

The Village has the ability to email you a copy of your monthly utility bill. The email is sent the same day the bills are produced and delivered to the Post Office. This copy of your bill can work as a back-up in case you do not receive the blue postcard bill in the mail – and you can use it to pay from. Utility bills are mailed every month on or before the 21st and are always due on the 7th of the following month by 5:00 p.m. in order to avoid a late fee. Whether or not you receive your bill in the mail, you are responsible for knowing when it is due.


Spring Clean Up

FREEBURG ESDA

Do you know what to do if a tornado watch or warning is issued? ESDA Coordinator Gene Kramer would like to provide some important safety tips to help stay safe in a tornado event. A tornado watch is issued when a tornado is possible in and near the watch area. A tornado warning means a tornado has been sighted or indicated by weather radar. Tornado warnings indicate imminent danger to life and property. Go immediately underground to a basement, storm cellar or an interior room (closet, hallway or bathroom). If you don't have that option, St. Paul's United Church of Christ at 7 N. Belleville will have their basement open whenever a tornado warning is issued. Remember – the Village of Freeburg will initiate an emergency call to the residents when a tornado watch is issued. Please make sure your current phone number is in our database. 
