PUBLIC WORKS

The Freeburg Public Works Department will be flushing fire hydrants over the next four-to-six weeks. Customers may experience a difference in the taste and odor of the water. The water should clear up within 24 hours and is safe to drink during these times. The Village has a supply of iron pills if your laundry becomes discolored. Please stop by Village Hall to pick some up.

Mosquitoes and Zika Virus: With all of the rain we have received this spring/summer, it is especially important to be aware of mosquitoes and the Zika virus. This virus is spread primarily through the bite of an infected mosquito. To control mosquitoes outside your home, make sure all screens are free from tears. Once a week, empty and scrub, turn over, cover or throw out any items that hold water like tires, buckets, birdbaths or trash containers. Use an outdoor flying insect spray where mosquitoes rest in dark, humid areas. FOR MORE INFO, go to the Community, then Health tab on our website.
