The Public Works Committee Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 4, 2015, by Chairman Dean Pruett. Members present were Chairman Dean Pruett, Trustee Mike Blaies, Trustee Ray Matchett, Trustee Elizabeth Niebruegge (absent), Mayor Seth Speiser, Village Clerk Jerry Menard, Trustee Lisa Meehling, Trustee Matt Trout, Public Works Director John Tolan, Village Administrator Tony Funderburg (absent) and Office Manager Julie Polson.

A. OLD BUSINESS:

1. Approval of October 14, 2015 minutes: *Trustee Ray Matchett motioned to approve the October 14, 2015 minutes and Trustee Mike Blaies seconded the motion. All voting yea, the motion carried.*
2. Sewer project: Public Works Director John Tolan has nothing new. Mayor Speiser advised Administrator Funderburg contacted Haier Plumbing and told them we are ready to go. They won't start until after Thanksgiving.
3. Sewer issues: John reported there has been no more diesel fuel smell.
4. Countryside Lane annexations: Mayor Speiser said we are waiting on Smithton Township. John started on the water line this week.
5. FSH Minutes: Julie included what we were given. We did not get any FSH minutes.
6. Water Line Extension on Rentchler Road: Mayor Speiser said Mr. Ehret just dug a well for his house, so this item can be taken off the agenda.
7. FSH Contract: John advised everyone met last week regarding the contract and it went very well. He said having both Attorney Manion and Attorney Durso there was very helpful. We discussed switching people over and paying tap on fees and agreed on 20 years for the length of contract. We don't want FSH competing against Freeburg, Smithton or Hecker for water customers. Tony will come up with a definitive lined map, and will get preannexation agreements with whichever community that will serve the resident.

John reported the water hydrant flushing was completed yesterday, and we had no big issues this time.

B. NEW BUSINESS: John will collect the THM samples this month.

C. GENERAL CONCERNS: None.

D. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION: None.
