FREEBURG CLEAN UP

The Village of Freeburg is scheduling another beautification project for residents and businesses of Freeburg. Dumpsters will be placed on the south end of the municipal Power Plant lot, off South Railroad Street, beginning Thursday, April 22, 2021 and run through Saturday, April 24, 2021, from 12:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. on Thursday and 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturday.

During this time, dumpsters will be provided by the Village to assist everyone during this beautification project. Businesses and private citizens are encouraged to use the dumpsters for depositing trash they have accumulated. The Village staff will be there to assist you in unloading your trash.

There are a few rules to follow for using the dumpsters. YOU MUST BE A RESIDENT OF THE VILLAGE OF FREEBURG. Please place the refuse in the dumpsters, NOT along the side. NO vehicle tires, grass or tree trimmings are to be placed in the trash receptacles. Arrangements will be made to empty the dumpsters as needed.

TV's and auto and light truck tires will be accepted this year payable in cash at the time of disposal. NO AG TIRES WILL BE ACCEPTED. TV's will be charged by weight for all TV's at \$0.50 cents per pound. Auto and light truck tires will cost \$3 per tire with no rim and \$7 per tire with rim. You can bring the following items to the clean up: refrigerators, dish washers, washers, dryers, hot water heaters, freezers or air conditioners. These items are NOT to be placed in the trash receptacles. An area will be clearly marked for drop off of household white items. For safety reasons, refrigerator doors are to be dismantled prior to dropping off the item.

Electronic that can be recycled include computer towers, computer parts (CRT boards, power supplies, CPU, fans, battery backups, modems, etc.); motors, hard drives, floppy drives, CD Rom drives, DVD players, laptops, batteries, printers, cell phones, etc. For a complete list of items that will be accepted, please visit our website at www.freeburg.com.
